Greater Valdosta Community Christmas Parade December 5, 2020 6pm-until

Please read through the below information, as it has been updated and several changes have been made.

• This year's theme is Christmas Lights & Winter Nights!

- The parade will begin at the corner of Woodrow Wilson Drive and Patterson Street and continue south on Patterson Street. It will disband at the old Bank of America building in Downtown.
- <u>Units may begin lining up at 3pm until 5p.m.</u> On Woodrow Wilson Drive. <u>Traffic must enter from Ashley Street</u>, where you will be directed to your position. Line up for the parade is on a "first-come" basis.
- To maintain the overall effect of the parade, all entries must be decorated in a holiday theme or the theme of the parade & will be strictly enforced. Decorative lighting is encouraged.
- Float entries are highly encouraged/ **preferred** as it makes the parade more enjoyable. Only floats will be judged. A float is classified as a truck pulling a trailer or flatbed. Float decorations and parade float kits may be purchased at www.victorycorps.com
- All entries must maintain FORWARD MOVEMENT during the entirety of the parade. This includes all walking groups/ dance teams/ preforming groups. This will be STRICTLY ENFORCED. Violators may be asked to leave the parade procession at any time and will be prohibited from entering next year's parade as this causes large gaps in the parade procession.
- <u>All entrants must have identification signs on both sides and/or front of their entry with a *MINIMUM* of six inch <u>letters.</u> Television coverage cameras and program announcers must be able to easily read the name of the unit or sponsor. Handwritten signs will not be accepted. Please have your signs printed or made so that they look nice to attendees as well as on site media and parade spotters.</u>

• If music is played on or from a parade entry, the music must be appropriate to the Christmas season and theme of the parade. Vulgar music/sounds that is/are questionable in content will not be permitted and you will be asked to leave parade immediately.

• Semi-Trucks are allowed to be used to pull floats. Please make sure the trailer tandems are pushed up.

• <u>Enclosed cars will not be accepted as parade entries</u>, with the exception of official vehicles that have received prior approval from the Parade Committee. Cars and pickup trucks may be used as floats if they are decorated with the parade theme. <u>Individuals will not be allowed to ride on the hoods of vehicles/ no acceptations</u>.

• No entrant shall be dressed as Santa Claus.

- Any pageant winner is welcome to participate in the parade by providing her own convertible or float and paying the required entry fee and signage that is professionally printed and fits within the sign guidelines.
- A description of the entrant, in 25 words or less, must be turned in with the application. This information will be used by television announcers and parade emcees as you pass through Downtown.

- Parade Marshals have the authority to seek the removal of any person or units from the parade, when, in their judgment, parade guidelines are being violated.
- Fees should be paid by November 20, 2020. There will be a **\$25 late fee** for applications and fees received after November 20th.
- Applications may be mailed to the **Ossipe Temple No. 65**, PO Box 874, Valdosta, GA 31603-9998 or placed in the drop box in the **Valdosta City Hall Annex** outside of the **Main Street Office**.
- Entry fees are non-refundable. Rain dates will be on December 12, 2020 is weather becomes an issue. The Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse entry of any application in any division of the parade Cash, Check or Money Order only. NO CREDIT CARDS!
- <u>Floats will be judged on Overall Appearance (first impression and visual appeal)</u>, <u>Special Effects (created by use of lights or luminous materials</u>), <u>Creativity/Workmanship</u> (unusual use of material, special designs) and <u>Use of Theme</u>.

In the interest of safety:

-Trailers with exposed wheels will not be allowed to participate in the parade. Wheels must have fenders or covers.

-Parade participants are required to have their hands and legs inside of the vehicle or trailer at all times. Body parts must not hang from trailer.

-No candy or items of any kind may be thrown from the parade floats or cars. Entrants wishing to distribute items/candy must have individuals walking beside the parade entry.

-Burnouts or stunt driving maneuvers will not be tolerated,
